occurring and acc	epted the offer from	some units to attend	the location	on to ass	sist me.	On arrival in Mi	llmarsh			
Lane it was obviou	us that something wa	s about to happen. The	here were a	number	of group	os of teenagers wh	no were			
milling around cle	arly looking for some	ething. Millmarsh La	ne is an ind	ustrial r	oad with	two major 24hr fa	actories			
but borders residential areas which are divided apart by Mollison Road. At this time on a Saturday the streets										
were very quiet se	o these groups stuck	out. After a brief s	earch I not	iced two	o metal g	gates next to the	Greggs			
Factory which su	ddenly closed as w	e passed them. We	stopped as	nd I go	t out an	d approached the	gates.			
Although dark, str	reet lighting was on	and I could see a mal	e was usin	g a chai	n and lo	ck to secure the g	ates. I			
could hear music coming from further inside. Stood by the gate I immediately noticed an IC3 male who I know										
to be Simon CORDELL: I recognised Mr Cordell as I have previously spoken to him recently at illegal raves										
where I have seen him setting up sound equipment and subsequently taking it away when confronted by Police. I										
explained to Mr Cordell why we were there but he immediately denied it was a rave. Mr Cordell stated first it										
was a private conference but then said it was a birthday party. When asked about permission to be there he stated										
friends were squatting on the land and they had said he could stay. I explained to Mr Cordell that I needed to										
come onto the site to see what was going on as for all I knew he could be damaging it or stealing from it.										
Eventually after promising I would not remove anyone squatting and only myself and Pc Ames would come in,										
Mr Cordell agreed that we could come in. Near to the gate was a silver Ford Focus index MA57LDY which I										
knew was Mr Cordoll's. The boot was open and I noticed it contained three large thin industrial gas bottles.										
From experience I knew this was likely to contain nitrous oxide which is currently used on the rave scene as a
