On Wednesday the 20<sup>th</sup> of Aug at approx 11:00 I was in plain-cloths with PC Anderson 240 YE doing door to door enquiries regarding a "Rave" that occurred on Friday 6<sup>th</sup>, Saturday 7<sup>th</sup>, Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> of JUNE 2014.

We conducted a door to door enquiries on ORCHARD TERRACE, GREAT CAMBRIDGE ROAD we spoke to a resident who wished not to be named who stated that she had been alarmed by the sound of a window being smashed next door to her house, there were large crowds of young people gathering outside her house which backs on to the factory. There was a lot of shouting and lots of cars seen to be coming and going all night long. The resident stated that during the day there were lots of "cuptles" lying on the ground and so much rubbish every where, and caused the whole family to feel alarmed and very concerned.
