| <p>Post 9th November 2012 homeless applicants :</p> <p>Households placed in temporary accommodation, pending being made an offer of a private rented home to discharge the Council's duty</p> <p>Homeless applicants who applied for homelessness assistance on or after 12 November 2012 and who are owed the full housing duty will be entitled to 200 points. If a homeless applicant accepts or refuses an offer of private accommodation in discharge of the Council's duty the applicant's 200 points will be automatically removed.</p> | 200                          | 1.
