<p>Pre 9th November 2012 homeless applicants:</p> <p>The household is working and been assessed as experiencing financial hardship because income from work is not enough to meet rent payments.</p>	800	1. Date of moving into temporary accommodation
<p>Pre 9th November 2012 homeless applicants:</p> <p>Non-working households where the household's welfare benefits have been reduced by Government welfare reform and the Council has carried out an assessment and decided that they are not in a position to find work and are experiencing financial hardship.</p>	650	1. Date of moving into temporary accommodation
<p>Pre- 9th November 2012 homeless applicants</p> <p>Households in accommodation provided by Enfield Council owed a full housing duty under the homelessness law</p>	600	1. Date of moving into temporary accommodation
<p>Post 9th November 2012 homeless applicants :</p> <p>Households placed in temporary accommodation, pending being made an offer of a private rented home to discharge the Council's duty</p> <p>Homeless applicants who applied for homelessness assistance on or after 12 November 2012 and who are owed the full housing duty will be entitled to 200 points. If a homeless applicant accepts or refuses an offer of private accommodation in discharge of the Council's duty the applicant's 200 points will be automatically removed.</p>	200	1.
